

The University of North Carolina at Pembroke invites applications for the position of Assistant Women's Soccer Coach and Lecturer. UNC Pembroke is a member of NCAA Division II and located in Pembroke, North Carolina, a quiet and growing southeastern NC community located 15 minutes from Lumberton, NC. Campus is just off Interstate 95 and US Highway 74 and is convenient to all major metro areas of the Carolinas as well as world famous beaches and golfing resorts. UNC Pembroke boasts one of the most diverse student populations in the nation. UNC Pembroke has experienced enrollment records in each of the past five years and currently has a student body of 5,500. UNC Pembroke is a public, four-year master's degree-granting university and is part of the University of North Carolina system.

The Assistant Women's Soccer Coach will be a member of the UNCP faculty and must be eligible to teach in the UNC System. Teaching responsibilities will be assigned within the HPER Dept and School of Education with a strong preference for candidates that can teach test and measurements. The Assistant Soccer Coach will report to the Women's Head Soccer Coach and be assigned essential tasks that may include: on and off campus recruiting; developing a competitive Division II schedule; budget management of assigned funds; effectively work and communicate with students, equipment purchases, monitoring academic progress of student-athletes,; possess knowledge of overall soccer skills in order to develop players in every position; adherence to and promotion of NCAA rules and compliance to staff, student athletes and representatives of athletic interest; successfully complete NCAA recruiting exam, team building, and community and public relations. The successful candidate will demonstrate an understanding and commitment to athletic programs at NCAA Division II level, have a commitment to the academic mission of The University of North Carolina at Pembroke, a commitment to the academic success of the student athletes, serve as a positive role model for student athletes on and off the soccer field, work well with students, faculty, staff, and community. The candidate should also have a demonstrated understanding and strong commitment to cultural diversity.

Qualifications: A Master's degree is required with a preference for it to be in Physical Education, Recreation, Exercise Science, Health or some closely related field. Applicants should submit a resume, a cover letter including statements on their philosophy regarding the role of athletics in higher education and why they are qualified for the position, and the names, addresses and telephone numbers of three professional references. Please include e-mail addresses and fax numbers for the references and applicant if available. A completed application for finalists will require all official transcripts and three letters of professional references. UNCP Strongly encourages applications for this position from females
