Notes: Table created by comparing APRs to historical squad GSRs and federal graduation rates for approximately N=5,600 squads with both rates available (using equipercentile method). This table should be considered a fairly rough guide only (especially at the tails of the distribution) until contemporary graduation rates are available for squads in the APR cohort. Note that this table will continue to change as the APR formula changes and as we move toward a four-year data collection.
