Background: The NCAA Division I Women's Basketball Issues Committee requested the subcommittee examine the definition of a prospective student-athlete and to study whether changes are warranted to allow for specific exceptions in the way an institution interfaces with a prospective student-athlete who has graduated from high school and has signed a National Letter of Intent (NLI) (or for those institution's not using the NLI, a written offer of financial aid and/or offer of admission).

Anticipated Action: None.

7. Discuss student-athlete reinstatement cases involving recruiting violations. [Attachment D]

Background: The NCAA Division I Committee on Student-Athlete Reinstatement is seeking input from the subcommittee to ensure that appropriate weight is being given to violations of particular recruiting bylaws. The Committee on Student-Athlete Reinstatement has expressed concern over imposing a withholding condition on a prospective student-athlete who may have been innocently involved in the violation, yet a significant recruiting advantage was gained by the involved institution. Feedback is being sought from the subcommittee in an attempt to identify the most significant recruiting violations and the most appropriate means to address them.
