DePaul University

George Washington University - We feel the current legislation is adequate and there is not need for further regulation.

Iowa State University - Iowa State University would be fine with the size restriction of this proposal, but the content restrictions are unnecessary.

Kansas State University - Kansas State University is requesting an override on 2006-39.

Marquette University - We are not in favor of this proposal.

Northwestern State University - The size requirement is understandable, but an institution should not be limited from listing accomplishments (i.e. championships, APR).

Providence College - Providence College wishes to request an Override for Proposal 2006-39. Our coaches like the current legislation for the note cards, with them being a little more personable for a specific coach. Also if this proposal were to become effective, this would put an extra cost to re-order a new set of notes cards for the entire coaching staff as well as a waste to discard the current institutional note cards.

Southern Illinois University at Carbondale - Amend the legislation to include limited pre-printed information (i.e., sport, address, name of coach, phone number, email). I do not understand why pictures and accolades are impermissible but if they want to de-emphaize those things, so be it!

Syracuse University

Texas Tech University - Texas Tech supports the size restriction but does not support regulating content.

University of Akron - This proposal does not limit the playing field. It will require many smaller institutions to have to repurchase items that they have already purchased in bulk, costing those schools thousands of dollars. A better way to level the playing field is by only limiting the size of the institutional note card. There is no reason to limit the a schools creativity within that confined space.

University of Alabama, Tuscaloosa

University of Colorado, Boulder - The University of Colorado is in agreement with the size restriction, but not in agreement with the restriction on what's on the cover of the notecard and not in agreement with restricting the content (no pre-printed information)on the inside.

University of Connecticut - This is absurd.

University of Nebraska, Lincoln

University of New Hampshire - We have no problem with the size restriction, but the remainder of the proposal is too restrictive and limits an institution's ability to communicate in an effective and cost effective manner. This type of micro-managing is really inappropriate.

University of Notre Dame

University of Texas at Austin - The institution requests an override to proposal 2006-39 as it currently stands. The institution would support an amendment that only restricts the size of the institutional notecards, but not the content. It is the institution's position that the concern is related more to the size rather than the content of these recruiting materials as the size is what primarily impacts the prospects. The size also increases the printing and mailing cost of these items. Thus, reducing the size still helps to reduce the overall budgeting concerns, while allowing institution's the flexibility to be creative in the content. If not amendments are made, however, the institution prefers to leave the design and content of institutional notecards to each individual institution.
