1. First-time, full-time degree seeking students on athletics aid

- a. **Enrolled 1996.** Enter the number of first-time, full-time baccalaureate-degree seeking students who entered your institution the fall of 1996 and received athletics aid for your selected sport (this number should be the same as reported on your institution’s IPEDS GRS-1 form).
- b. **Graduated.** Enter the number of those student-athletes in (1a) who graduated with a baccalaureate degree from your institution by the end of the 2002 summer term.

2. First-time, full-time degree seeking students not on athletics aid

a. **Enrolled.** Enter the number of first-time, full-time baccalaureate-degree seeking students who entered your institution the fall of 1996 and did not receive athletics aid for the selected sport, but who were listed on your institution's squad list as of the first date of competition in the traditional segment of that sport. Include in this number any students who entered your institution the Winter quarter/Spring semester of 1997 (whether or not they received athletics aid) and were listed on your institution's squad list as of the first date of competition in the traditional segment of that sport.

Note: Multisport student-athletes should be tracked for each sport consistent with your institution's squad lists.

b. **Graduated.** Enter the number of those student-athletes in (2a) who graduated with a baccalaureate degree from your institution by the end of the 2002 summer term.

c. **Allowable Exclusions.** Enter the students who can be excluded from the cohort per IPEDS definition (those who died or became permanently disabled, those who left school to join a foreign service organization, those who left school to attend a church mission, those who left school to join the armed forces).

d. **Left while Eligible.** Enter those students who left your institution while academically eligible to compete according to NCAA rules. Please include student-athletes who left your institution after exhausting their eligibility, but prior to obtaining a degree. For these students, please provide the student-athletes ethnicity and social security numbers in the area provided below and the NCAA will attempt to verify the student-athlete's transfer with the National Student Clearinghouse. 3. Student-athletes transferring INTO your institution.

- a. **Enrolled.** Enter the number of student-athletes transferring INTO your institution who are listed on the squad list for the selected sport and were placed into the entering freshman class of 1996 based upon the number of credits accepted by your institution. These student-athletes can enter your institution at any time during the academic year.

Report transfer student-athletes separately based upon the type of institution the student-athletes transferred from, either two-year, or four-year.

Example: A student-athlete transfers to your institution during the 1997-98 academic year with 30 acceptable credit hours. Based on your institution's standards for transfers, the student-athlete is considered part of the sophomore class at the time of transfer. Since the student-athlete is considered a sophomore for the 1997-98 academic year, he/she would be placed in the entering freshman class of 1996.

It is important to note that you need to check each academic year. If a student-athlete transfers to your institution in 1998 and is considered part of the junior class at transfer, place that individual in the 1996 freshman class and include him/her in this report.

- b. **Graduated.** Enter the number of those student-athletes in (3a) who graduated with a baccalaureate degree from your institution by the end of the 2002 summer term.
- c. **Allowable Exclusions.** Enter the students who can be excluded from the cohort per IPEDS definition (those who died or became permanently disabled, those who left school to join a foreign service organization, those who left school to attend a church mission, those who left school to join the armed forces).
