Intent:

To permit an individual (prospective or student-athletes) to compete on an Olympic team or national team that may be competing for prize money or is being compensated by the governing body to participate in a specific event, provided the individual does not accept the prize money or any other compensation.

A Bylaws: Amend 12.2.3.2 by adding new 12.2.3.2.2 , page 55 , as follows:

[Division III]

"12.2.3.2 Competition with Professionals. Subsequent to initial full-time collegiate enrollment, an individual shall not be eligible for intercollegiate athletics in a sport if the individual ever participated on a team and knew (or had reason to know) that the team was a professional team (per Bylaw 12.02.4) in that sport. However, an individual may compete on a tennis, golf, two-person sand volleyball or two-person synchronized diving team(s) with persons who are competing for cash or a comparable prize, provided the individual does not receive payment of any kind for such participation.

[12.2.3.2.1 unchanged.]

"12.2.3.2.2. Olympic/National Teams. It is permissible for an individual (prospective student-athlete or student-athletes) to participate on Olympic or national teams that are competing for prize money or are being compensated by the governing body to participate in a specific event, provided the student-athlete does not accept prize money or any other compensation (other than actual and necessary expenses)."

A Bylaws: Amend 4.1.2 , page 22 , as follows:

[Division III]

"4.1.2 Duties and Responsibilities. The Executive Committee shall:

[4.1.2-(a) through 4.1.2-(j) unchanged.]

"(k) Call for an annual or Special Convention of the Association; *and*

"(l) Review and coordinate the catastrophic-injury and professional career insurance (disability injury/illness) programs; **and**

"(m) Compile the names of those individuals associated with intercollegiate athletics who died during the year immediately preceding the annual Convention."

B Bylaws: Amend 21.1.4.1 , page 220 , as follows:

[Division III]

"21.1.4 Memorial Resolutions Committee.

"21.1.4.1 Composition. The Memorial Resolutions Committee shall consist of five members, at least one from each membership division.

"21.1.4.2 Duties. The committee shall be responsible for compiling the names of those individuals associated with intercollegiate athletics who died during the year immediately preceding the annual Convention. The committee shall make its report each year; memorializing the individuals involved, during the business sessions of the annual Convention."
