To permit an individual prior to initial full-time collegiate enrollment to accept actual and necessary expenses associated with the individual's practice and competition on a professional team.

A Bylaws: Amend 12.1.1 , page 52 , as follows:

[Division III]

"12.1.1 Amateur Status. An individual loses amateur status and thus shall not be eligible for intercollegiate competition in a particular sport if the individual:

"(a) Uses his or her athletics skill (directly or indirectly) for pay in any form in that sport, except that prior to collegiate enrollment an individual may accept prize money based on his or her place finish or performance from the sponsor of an open athletics event, the United States Olympic Committee or the appropriate national governing body **and actual and necessary expenses associated with the individual's practice and competition on a professional team;**"

Intent:

To specify that an individual who participates on a major junior A ice hockey team shall be subject to the seasons of competition rule regardless of when the participation on the major junior A team occurs.

A Bylaws: Amend 12.2.3.2.4 , page 56 , as follows:

[Division III]

"12.2.3.2.4 Major Junior A Ice Hockey. *Ice hockey teams in the United States and Canada, classified by the Canadian Amateur Hockey Association as major junior A teams, are considered professional teams under NCAA legislation. An individual who participates on a major junior A ice hockey team shall be subject to the seasons of competition regulations set forth in Bylaw 14.2.4.3, regardless of when such participation occurs.*

"12.2.3.2.4.1 Limitation on Restoration of Eligibility. An appeal for restoration of eligibility may be submitted on behalf of an individual who has participated on a major junior A ice hockey team under the provisions of Bylaw 14.11;

however, such individual shall be denied at least the first year of intercollegiate athletics competition in the sport of ice hockey at the certifying institution and shall be charged with the loss of at least one season of eligibility in the sport of ice hockey."
