Further, to establish the composition of the panel as eight members, including the chair of the Division I Championships/Competition Cabinet, and two representatives each from Divisions II and III, including the NCAA Division II Championships Committee and NCAA Division III Championships Committee chairs. [Note: The proposed change involves a common provision and, thus, must be approved by each of the Divisions I, II and III governance structures, acting independently.]
