Immediate	To permit the NCAA (or a third party acting on behalf of the NCAA) to use a student-athlete's name or photograph in materials promoting NCAA championships or other NCAA events, activities or programs.
NC-2	ELIGIBILITY — PRACTICE WAIVER — UNITED STATES OLYMPIC COMMITTEE/ NATIONAL GOVERNING BODY	Ready for Consideration by Management Council	NCAA Division III Presidents Council [Management Council (Olympic Sports Liaison Committee)].	August 1, 2005	To permit student-athletes with eligibility remaining, who are not enrolled full time, to participate in practices for national governing bodies' team sports.
NC-3	PLAYING AND PRACTICE SEASONS — INFORMAL PRACTICE SCRIMMAGES	Ready for Consideration by Management Council	NCAA Division III Presidents Council [Management Council (Interpretations and Legislation Committee)].	Immediate	In basketball and football, to eliminate the requirement that informal practice scrimmages with outside competition be conducted in privacy.

Immediate	In bowling, to modify the playing and practice season so that all competition concludes by the last date of final exams for the academic year.

Immediate	To specify that on the Committee on Competitive Safeguards and Medical Aspects of Sports, one of the three members from the field of medicine shall be a board certified orthopedic specialist.
