Immediate	For purposes of applying extensions of the 10-semester/15-quarter rule, to specify that a circumstance considered beyond the control of the student-athlete includes the student-athlete being unable to participate in collegiate athletics due to a life threatening or incapacitating injury or illness suffered by a member of the student-athlete's immediate family, which is clearly supported by contemporaneous medical documentation.
