### **Fall Sport Acclimatization Models**

This supplement includes the following information:

1. The original fall sport acclimatization recommendation from the NCAA Committee on Competitive Safeguards and Medical Aspect of Sport (CSMAS).
2. Division III sport committee feedback to the original recommendation.
3. Division II fall sport acclimatization model.
4. A history of the CSMAS and NCAA Division III Management Council Playing and Practice Season Subcommittee action on football and other fall sport acclimatization.

Prior to the April 10 meeting, the subcommittee will receive via e-mail the latest report from the 2004 fall studies of preseason time and illnesses. This report will show the correlations the subcommittee requested at its January meeting. Also prior to the meeting, the subcommittee will receive feedback from CSMAS regarding the Division III specific findings and its implication on CSMAS's originally recommended model.

At the April 10 meeting, the subcommittee will have the opportunity to formulate a fall sport model that can be presented to the sport committees for additional feedback prior to the July legislative deadline.
