Senior Woman Administrator

Division I

4.02.4.1 Institutional Senior Woman Administrator

An institutional senior woman administrator is the highest ranking female administrator involved with the conduct of a member institution's intercollegiate athletics program. *(Adopted: 11/1/01 effective 8/1/02)*

4.02.4.2 Conference Senior Woman Administrator

A conference senior woman administrator is a female administrator, preferably no lower in rank than assistant commissioner, involved with the conduct and policy processes of a member conference's office. *(Adopted: 11/1/01 effective 8/1/02)*

Division II

4.02.4 Senior Woman Administrator

A senior woman administrator is a female professional athletics administrator who is a member of the institution's senior athletics management team. This female administrator must have substantive responsibilities for the conduct and administration of an institution's overall athletics program, and her gender should not dictate only gender-specific duties and responsibilities. An institution with a female director of athletics may designate a different female professional athletics administrator to serve as the institution's senior woman administrator. *(Revised: 1/13/03 effective 8/1/03)*

Division III

4.02.4 Senior Woman Administrator

A senior woman administrator is the highest ranking female administrator involved with the conduct of a member institution's intercollegiate athletics program.

4.02.4.1 Female Athletics Director

An institution with a female director of athletics may appoint a different female who reports to the director of athletics as the senior woman administrator. *(Adopted 1/14/02, effective 8/1/02)*
