August 1, 2005	To specify that violations of Constitution 3.2.4.8 are institutional violations and shall not affect a student-athlete's eligibility.

Immediate	To specify that the Management Council, on recommendation from the Membership Committee, shall have the authority to place an institution that has completed its provisional or reclassification process in restricted membership status for its first year of active Division III membership. The Membership Committee shall establish the parameters of restricted membership, which may include, but is not limited to, loss of any or all championship access, voting privileges, Division III grants and initiatives and catastrophic insurance.

Immediate	To amend the criteria defining a professional athletics team by replacing the term "other reasonable expenses incidental to participation" with "other reasonable expenses."

Immediate	To specify that an individual who never participates in intercollegiate athletics, although the individual's enrollment may have been enlisted by a member of the athletics staff or other representatives of the institution's athletics interests with a view towards the student's ultimate participation in the intercollegiate athletics program, is not considered a student-athlete.
