Bylaws: Amend 12.5.1.1 by adding new 12.5.1.1.7, pages 58-60, as follows:

"12.5.1.1 Institutional, Charitable, Educational or Nonprofit Promotions. A member institution or recognized entity thereof (e.g., fraternity, sorority or student government organization), a member conference or a noninstitutional charitable, educational or nonprofit agency may use a student-athlete's name, picture or appearance to support its charitable or educational activities or to support activities considered incidental to the student-athlete's participation in intercollegiate athletics, provided the following conditions are met:

[12.5.1.1-(a) through 12.5.1.1-(i) unchanged.]

[12.5.1.1.1 through 12.5.1.1.6 unchanged.]

"12.5.1.17 Prospective Student-Athlete's Participation in Institutional Fund-Raisers or Promotions. Prospective student-athletes may not be involved in institutional fund-raisers or promotional activities prior to initial full-time enrollment."

Additional Information: Prospective student-athletes should not be involved in fund-raising for trips or activities in which they may not participate. Further, the prospective student-athletes should not feel the pressure to begin these activities prior to initial full-time enrollment.
