August 1, 2007	To add anti-estrogens to the list of banned-drug classes and to specify that medical exceptions for the use of anti-estrogens may be made by the Executive Committee for those student-athletes with a documented medical history demonstrating the need for regular use of such drugs.
NC-8	AWARDS AND BENEFITS -- EXPENSES PROVIDED BY THE INSTITUTION FOR PRACTICE AND COMPETITION -- PERMISSIBLE -- TRAVEL TO REGULAR-SEASON CONTESTS DURING VACATION PERIOD	Ready for Consideration by Management Council	NCAA Division III Management Council (Interpretations and Legislation Committee).	Immediate	To permit an institution to provide transportation expenses for a student-athlete to travel from campus to the site of a regular-season contest and back to campus during a vacation period even if the student-athlete does not travel with the team, provided the student-athlete pays the difference in cost associated with traveling to a site
