Immediate	To clarify the actual areas of study included in the NCAA Division III Institution Self-Study Guide (ISSG).
M-2	RECRUITING — PERMISSION TO CONTACT — SELF-RELEASE — 30-DAY EXPIRATION	Ready for Ratification at Convention	NCAA Division III Management Council.	August 1, 2004	To establish a 30-day period during which the permission to contact granted by the student-athlete remains in effect.
M-3	RECRUITING — PERMISSION TO CONTACT — SELF-RELEASE — PRIVACY AND DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS	Ready for Ratification at Convention	NCAA Division III Interpretations and Legislation Committee.	Immediate	To indicate that contact based on the initial self-release must remain private unless and until the student-athlete decides to transfer to another institution or issues a second self-release to the same institution.
M-4	ELIGIBILITY — TWO-YEAR DEGREE PROGRAMS	Ready for Ratification at Convention	NCAA Division III Presidents Council [Management Council (Academic Issues Subcommittee)].	Immediate	To specify that student-athletes enrolled in two-year degree programs shall only be eligible if admitted to the institution under the same standards as four-year degree seeking students, and if the two-year degree program is not a terminal program.
M-5	ELIGIBILITY — DETERMINING SEASON OF ELIGIBILITY — MINIMUM AMOUNT OF PARTICIPATION — EXCEPTION	Ready for Ratification at Convention	NCAA Division III Presidents Council [Management Council (Interpretations and Legislation Committee)].	August 1, 2004	To clarify that a student-athlete may not use the exception to the minimum amount of competition bylaw if the student-athlete missed the traditional segment for academic probation or ineligibility.
M-6	ELIGIBILITY - CRITERIA FOR ADMINISTRATION OF HARDSHIP WAIVER — MEDICAL DOCUMENTATION	Ready for Ratification at Convention	NCAA Division III Presidents Council [Management Council (Interpretations and Legislation Committee)].	Immediate	To require contemporaneous medical documentation in support of a hardship-waiver request be submitted by a physician (i.e., a medical doctor) who administered care at the time of the injury or illness.

Immediate	To specify that to satisfy the minimum attendance requirement a student-athlete may combine terms of full-time (as opposed to full-time and part-time) attendance at multiple two-year colleges.

Immediate	In basketball, to eliminate the restriction on the number of student-athletes from the same institution who may compete on an outside team.
M-9	PLAYING AND PRACTICE SEASONS — DEFINITIONS AND APPLICATIONS — ATHLETICALLY RELATED ACTIVITIES	Ready for Ratification at Convention	NCAA Division III Presidents Council [Management Council (Interpretations and Legislation Committee)].	Immediate	To clarify that all athletically related activities held at the direction of or supervised by any member of an institution's coaching staff are considered practice.

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M-10	PLAYING AND PRACTICE SEASONS — NONTRADITIONAL SEGMENT — PRACTICE AND CONTEST LIMITATIONS	Ready for Ratification at Convention	NCAA Division III Presidents Council [Management Council (Interpretations and Legislation Committee)].	August 1, 2004	In baseball, field hockey, lacrosse, soccer, softball and women's volleyball, to clarify that practice and competition in the nontraditional segment is limited to 16 practice days, including one date of competition. In football, to clarify that the out-of-season conditioning and strength training sessions are limited to 16 practice days.
M-11	PLAYING AND PRACTICE SEASONS — SOCCER — PRESEASON SCRIMMAGE LIMITS	Ready for Ratification at Convention	NCAA Division III Presidents Council [Management Council (Playing and Practice Seasons Subcommittee)].	Immediate	In soccer, to specify that the one date of unlimited scrimmages in the soccer preseason practice period counts as one of the three allowable scrimmages that may occur before the first scheduled contest.

Immediate	To specify a governing sports committee shall deal with actions of misconduct incident to competition in a timely manner.
